Trails:

Arboretum: The trail is two 5K routes, do either one for 5K, or both 5Ks to make a 10K. Walk goes through Penn State Arboretum; several sports landmarks including Beaver Stadium, Penn State Sports Museum, and Medlar Field baseball stadium; through campus and the historic College Heights neighborhood. Both 5K trails pass the famous Berkey Creamery.

Boalsburg: The trail is on a paved bike path and on sidewalks through the village of Boalsburg. An alternate trail is available that avoids the two-mile bike path along Rt. 322. The bike path may be closed after heavy snows.

Town and Campus: The trail goes through State College and the Penn State Campus. The 10K trail starts at the Motel, but you must drive about a mile to the 5K start. Both trails pass the famous Berkey Creamery.

Start Location & Hours:

Open 24/7. Please walk during daylight hours only.

Registration Procedures: Ask for the walk box at the registration desk. Driving directions to alternate start points and the Arboretum start point are provided in the walk box. The alternate start points are within a couple of miles. See the "Physical Start Box" procedures on the General Information page.

Conditions: For the Arboretum walk, strollers and wheelchairs will find the route easy. For the Boalsburg walk strollers and wheelchairs will find the route hard. For the Town & Campus, strollers and wheelchairs will have medium difficulty. Pets are welcome, but not permitted in all buildings along the trail. Local law requires that all pets are leashed, and you must clean up after them.

Award & Fees: No award for this walk. IVV Credit Only is \$3.00. Children 12 and under are not charged for IVV credit.

Comfort & Facilities: Water and restrooms are available at the Start Point. Along the trail are public restrooms and restaurants where refreshments can be purchased. Recommend carrying water on this trail.

SPECIAL NOTE: During football games and special events on campus, the town is a popular destination. Traffic and visitors increase, it may be difficult to make overnight reservations. Before you travel check visitpennstate.org for local event activities.

From I-80: Take Exit 161, I-99/Rt. 26 S to Business Rt. 322 E, turn left on Branch Road, and an immediate left into motel parking lot.

From PA Turnpike: I-99N to Business Rt.322 E, turn left on Branch Road, and an immediate left into motel parking lot.

From Harrisburg: Rt. 322 W to Business Rt. 322 W, turn right on Branch Road, and an immediate left into motel parking lot. Parking is available at the hotel, at the Arboretum and in Boalsburg.
