### A Word from the President

Greetings Penn Dutch Pacers members and friends,

I finally have some good news – we have our first post-pandemic (if we are "post") traditional event scheduled. This will be our first event since the Lititz walk in February 2020. We are planning a walk on Saturday, October 1st, on the Northwest Lancaster County River Trail, starting northwest of Marietta at Riverfront Park and traveling towards Bainbridge. The 10K trail will feature the "While Cliffs of Conoy" (worth a look if you haven't been there before) as well as views of the river, the scenic Shocks Mill Railroad Bridge across the Susquehanna, and an island where eagles frequently nest. # IVV Olympiad/IML Texas Trail Roundup By Tom Jackson, KSVA President

For the first time ever, the IVV Olympiad is coming to North America in San Antonio, Texas. It is a back-to-back event with an IML event creating seven days of walk, bike, and swim events. The Olympiad is February 19-23, 2023, followed by Texas Trail Roundup, February 24-26. The American Volkssport Association will not have a Convention in 2023.

The IVV is the governing organization for all Volkssports; it governs the national organizations that belong to the IVV, like the American Volkssport Association. If you can think that the AVA Conventions are the biannual gathering of the Volkssporters in the United States, the Olympiad is the biannual gathering of all of Volkssporters in the world.

The International Marching League (IML) Walking Association endorses multi-day walks to promote health, international travel and friendship through walking. AVA clubs in the United States currently host two IML calendar events annually – the US Freedom Walk Festival in Arlington, Virginia (October 14-16, 2022) and the Texas Trail Roundup in San Antonio.

If you plan to go to San Antonio in February, you should be making hotel reservations and registering for the events now. If you want more information, there are links on the AVA web site.
