

Directions:

From the Southwest: Drive North on I-81 to Exit 48 (York Road). At the bottom of the ramp, turn right. Continue to second stoplight and turn left onto Fairview Street. Proceed to next stoplight and turn right onto Army Heritage Drive. Proceed straight through the next stoplight (intersection of Trindle Road and Army Heritage Drive). ****You will cross over I-81, USAHEC/USAMHI is located on the left side of the road. If you proceed to the railroad tracks, you have gone too far.**

From the South and Southeast: Drive towards Frederick, MD. Drive North on US 15 to Dillsburg, PA. Go Northwest on PA 74 for about 9.5 miles toward Carlisle. Just before I-81, turn right onto Fairview Drive. ****continue as above.**

From the Northeast and North: Go southwest on I-81 to Exit 49. At the bottom of the ramp, turn left onto Trindle Road. At next stoplight, turn left onto Army Heritage Drive. ****continue as above.**

From the East or West: From the PA Turnpike take Exit 226 to Route 11 South. Continue on Route 11 to the second traffic light, where Sheetz and Turkey Hill convenience stores are located. At this stoplight, turn left onto Harmony Hall Road. Take next right onto Claremont Road. Take first left onto Army Heritage Drive. Continue over railroad tracks, USAHEC/USAMHI is located on the right side of the road. If you proceed to stoplight, you have gone too far.

Sponsor: Susquehanna Rovers Volksmarch Club (AVA 328) in cooperation with the US Army Garrison, Carlisle Barracks and Army Heritage Education Center (AHEC).

Sanctioned: This event is sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports, which promotes leisure sports in interest of health, recreation, fun and companionship. This event counts towards the acquisition of IVV Achievement Awards.

Start/Finish: Army Heritage Education Center (AHEC) at 950 Soldiers Drive, Carlisle, PA 17013. There is plenty of free parking. Look for the Volksmarch sign and table. We will be close to the music.

Start Time: 8 am to 1 pm

Finish Time: All walkers must finish by 4 pm.

Fee/Award: This event is Free to those who wish to participate without IVV credit. IVV Credit is \$3.00. (Children 12 and under will not be charged to receive IVV Credit.) There will be no refunds.

Trail: The walk passes through the Army Heritage Trail, around the Carlisle Barracks Golf Course and enters the Carlisle Barracks where it passes numerous historic sites. The walk is on sidewalks, paved and natural surfaces and is suitable for wheelchairs and strollers. The 5K trail does not enter the Barracks. The 10K trail may change depending on regulations at the Carlisle Barracks at the time of the event. Both strollers and wheelchairs can manage the trail.

Conditions: All 10K walkers, 15 and above, must have a government issued, photo ID to enter the military installation (School IDs are acceptable forms of ID for children). No littering along the trail. Pets are permitted but must be leashed at all times. Restrooms are available at the Start/Finish and along the trail. Water and hard candy will be available at the Start/Finish and the checkpoint. The event is held rain or shine.

Eligibility: Everyone is welcome to participate. Children 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult.

Disclaimer: The America Volkssport Association or its subsidiary clubs are not responsible for theft or loss of personal belongings or property. Every reasonable effort will be made to make this a safe, educational and enjoyable event.

Procedure: AVA policy requires that every participant, fee or non-fee, sign the insurance waiver and obtain a numbered start card which is stamped at control points along the course. At the Finish, the validated card is turned in and IVV books are stamped for official credit, if the credit fee has been paid. We need to know that everyone is safely off the trail so all walkers **must** turn in their start cards. The trail may be walked a second time on the same day using the same start card at no additional cost.

Food: Food service will be provided for a fee at the Oktoberfest by several vendors.
